\_\_\_\_\_ **Non-voting Member:** A non-voting member is a person or entity engaged in oil and gas ancillary or support services, including, but not necessarily limited to, well drilling; natural gas processing; crude oil refining; well location, pipeline or similar construction or preparation; well logging; well re-working or servicing; brine treatment; oil, gas or water pumping or transport; and oil and gas well equipment or materials supply.
