Purpose of the workshop

At the December meeting of its Air Quality Technical Advisory Committee, the Department of Environmental Protection unveiled a preliminary draft of rules to reduce emissions of volatile organic compounds (VOC) from existing unconventional and conventional oil and gas well sites and related equipment. DEP officials emphasized the proposal is in a very early stage and the department wants to work with stakeholders as the process moves forward. However, an initial review of the draft regulations reveal they have the potential to impose a large burden on some operators, particularly conventional producers.

We are inviting you on February 27, 2019 to join other operators as we discuss the following:

- Draft Reasonably Available Control Technique Guideline (CTG) Reasonably Available Control Technology (RACT) Rule
- Regulated Sources under the Draft CTG RACT Rule
- Conventional vs Unconventional - Any differences under the Draft CTG RACT Rule?
- Rule Requirements - How will the rule affect my operations?
- Available Exemptions - Do my facilities qualify?
- Documenting Exempt Status - What does demonstrating that your operations are exempt actually entail?
- Financial Impacts - What is the potential cost associated with the proposed RACT requirements?
- Regulatory Process - Where are we now?
- Regulatory Schedule - When can we expect the RACT requirements to go from proposed to final?
- Action - This will impact you. What can you do?
